

Minutes of a meeting of Carham Parish Council, held in Carham Church on Tuesday 7th January 2014.

666.. Present. Councillors R.Brydon (in the chair) , Mrs A.Lauder Mrs A.Changleng, Mr B. Woodcock, Mrs J.Thomas, Mr D. Critchlow and Mr W.Potts. Also in attendance County Councillor Anthony Murray.

667. Apologies. Mr. S. Thorkildsen..

668. Declarations of Interest. None

669. Minutes of the meeting of 29th Oct. 2013, were approved, and signed .

670. Matters Arising. The subject of signs was brought up. Mrs J.Thomas said that she had repeatedly asked NCC to reveal what signs were needed and where, and where to obtain them. So far no reply was forthcoming.. Decided to wait till the next meeting .

671. Planning applications. Two planning permissions have been given, to (1) Internal alterations to Moles House, Wark,and (2) Four new houses to be built on the waste ground next to the car park.

672. Precept for 2014. Likely expenses for 2014 were discussed. It was agreed to apply for a precept of £1200.

673. Roadside Mirror. Discussion took place over who should pay for this. Clerk said that NCC would not sanction the payment proposed by Anthony Murray. At this point Councillor Murray joined the meeting and confirmed this decision.. David Critchlow said he had been in contact with NCC regarding extra traffic from the proposed new houses and he volunteered to take the matter up with them. Failing a satisfactory outcome, it was decided that we would pay for a mirror ourselves.

674. NALC. A letter had been received regarding a new system of setting the payment of NALC subscriptions, but for next year they are simply going to charge an extra 5%

675. WRVS Leaflets from WRVS on transport difficulties were handed round.

676. AOB. A sales leaflet on defibrillators had been received. However the price of £1400 for the cheapest one was prohibitive. Also where would it be kept.
