

Minutes of a meeting of Carham Parish Council, held in Carham Church on Tuesday 7th May 2013.

626. Minutes of the meeting of 20th March 2013, were approved, and signed .

627. Matters Arising. Notice has been given that the B6350 road.is to be tarred and chipped this summer, between Carham and Wark.. The Clerk intimated that he had written to the roads dept. requesting chevrons for the corner where the fatality had taken place, but had not had a reply. Suggested he try again.

628. Planning. (1) Mindrum. Conversion of two cottages into one has been approved by the N.C.C.

(2) A Planning Application has been received for the conversion of a former store house into a 4 bedroom dwelling.at Mindrum Mill. Plans were passed round and examined.. There were no objections to the proposal.

629. Election results. Following the election on the 2nd May 2013., all the council members filled in the “Declaration of acceptance of office “ form The “Register of Interests” form was given to all members to fill in and return to the Clerk before the last week in May.

630. Speeding. – Police training. The police in the Glendale area are looking for 8 volunteers to man speed guns in the local villages. They would be given the necessary training beforehand , but they would have to commit at least 4 hours per week. They would not be allowed to stop vehicles , it would just be a case of reporting back to the police any speeding offence.
